TWO CASE STUDIES

- Kerr-Tar Regional COG Triangle North Multi-Jurisdictional Business Parks
- Isothermal COG Grant application and Management for Large Project

TRIANGLE NORTH

- Kerr-Tar Regional COG led the way
 - Formulated idea and implemented it
 - EDA Grant
- Franklin, Granville, Vance, and Warren Counties joined together in a multi-jurisdictional industrial park effort through a nonprofit entity
 - Acquired and developed four large acreage industrial parks/one in each county

- Sanford Holshouser evaluated the sites to prioritize for development and to certify sites
- Law firm negotiated inter-local agreement to join the counties together through a non-profit
- Cited by the U.S. Department of Commerce as the best example of regional cooperation in the country
- Featured in *Southern Business & Development* magazine

HORSEHEAD CORPORATION PROJECT

- \$680 million dollar site selection project for metal recovery and smelting operation
- Focus on greenfield site
- Multiple grants needed for water and sewer infrastructure, new water supply, road improvements, rail improvements
- Isothermal COG played a lead role in preparing and managing over eight grants
- Project could not have been successful without Isothermal COG's involvement
